# Citizenship Requirements

- Legal Permanent Resident Card (Green Card)
- Birth Certificate
- E-mail
- Passports (Current and expired)
- State ID or Driver's License
- List of trips outside of the United States since you became a Legal Permanent Resident (MM-DD-YY)
- Complete list of employers for the last 5 years (Name; Address; Position; Dates of employment)
- Complete list of residences for the last 5 years with dates (MM-DD-YY)
- List of schools for the last five years (Name of school; address; and dates of attendance)
- Information about your marital history (current and ex-spouses). We will need the following information:
  1. Complete Name and Date of Birth
  2. Date of Marriage/ Date of Divorce
  3. Copy of Permanent Resident Card
  4. Copy of the Citizenship Certificate
  5. Marriage and Divorce Certificate from you and your spouse (if applicable)
- Children Birth Certificates (Including deceased, step-children, and adopted children) and address information.
- Citizenship applications are by appointment only
- All information must be complete, otherwise you will be asked to come back for a new appointment.
- If your father or mother is a United States Citizen, please bring a copy of the Naturalization Certificate
- If you have been arrested, you need to bring your Court Record (Certified Court Disposition)
- Selective Services Number and Date of Registration (Only applies to males born after 01/01/1960). If you need to find your number, please call: (847) 68-6888 or go to [www.sss.gov](http://www.sss.gov)
- Money Orders for the amount of:
  - \$640.00 payable to USCIS
  - \$85.00 payable to USCIS
  - \$200.00 payable to Centro Romero (includes the filing and mailing of the forms and passport style pictures)
  - \$30.00 payable to Centro Romero (Consultation)
- If you have been a Permanent Resident of the US for the last three years **AND** you have been married to and living with the same US Citizen Spouse for the last three years, you may qualify for citizenship. To determine your eligibility, please bring the following documents:
  - Joint bank statements
  - Credit card statements
  - Health, car, and life insurance
  - Utility bills
  - Any other document that proves you and your spouse are living together
- IRS Tax Returns for the last 3-5 years. To obtain your free record please call: 1-800-908-9946
- If you have any physical or mental disability that has been diagnosed that exempts you from taking the Constitution test of the United States, you will need to bring the form N-648 (your primary doctor must fill out this form) found on this website: <https://www.uscis.gov/sites/default/files/files/form/n-648.pdf>
